



About the Founder Chairman: Dr. B. V. Raman

Dr. B.V. Raman is India's most celebrated name in astrology in modern times and a man who dedicated his entire life to its study. He conducted intense research in Hindu astronomy, astro-psychology, weather and political forecasts, disease diagnosis, natural calamities, management and other areas in relation to celestial phenomena. He was Editor, The Astrological Magazine for over 62 years, a stint that merits a place in the Guinness Book of World Records. Dr. Raman travelled round the world several times, representing India at several prestigious international conferences. He was the first to deliver a lecture on 'Relevance of Astrology' in modern times in 1970 at the United Nations, New York. He founded the Indian Council of Astrological Sciences (Regd.) in 1984 to regulate the study and practice of astrology and founded the Raman & Rajeswari Research Foundation to promote the cause of the various aspects of eastern culture. He was assisted in his activities by his devoted wife Mrs. Rajeswari Raman who took keen interest in the study of Yoga, especially in its application to women. Dr. Raman believed in 'simple living and high thinking', something he practiced throughout his life. Possibly, there will never be another like him.

He has presented papers in various national and international conferences.
